Dear Residents

Recent storms can cause damage and heavy rains can disturb things in The Preserve. Have you observed a fallen tree, overgrown section of trail or litter that needs to be removed? Please contact the Preserve subcommittee of the Lake Pointe MUD via email at Preserve@lakepointemud.org with any issues related to the condition of The Preserve that need to be addressed, including:

- Trail blockages and hazards (fallen trees, broken limbs or overgrowth)
- Litter or evidence of illegal dumping
- Unusual, non-recreational activity

As a reminder, residents should not engage in any activity of remedying any trails using equipment or power tools.
