

# URGENT REMINDER: PARKING AND ACCESS AT TRAILHEAD/LAKE AREA AND CLOSURE

Lake Pointe Residents,

The Lake Pointe Municipal Utility District (MUD) is issuing a critical reminder regarding parking and site access at the Trailhead Parking Lot located at the bottom of the hill near the lake. As previously announced, this parking lot is now a fully fenced-off construction zone and is temporarily inaccessible to the public.

To ensure the safety of residents and the continuity of essential utility services, please adhere to the following:

- **Do Not Park Outside the Fenced Area:** Residents are strictly prohibited from parking their vehicles along the roadway or in the immediate vicinity of the construction fencing.
- **Do Not Block the Driveway:** It is vital that the driveway leading down to the lake remains completely clear at all times.
- **WTCPUA Access Required:** The West Travis County PUA (WTCPUA) requires unobstructed access to the water intake, building, and facilities on a daily basis. Blocking this access with parked vehicles interferes with critical water infrastructure operations.

To avoid blocking the roadway or utility access, please use the following alternative parking locations:

- **Vista Pointe Park**
- **The small parking area** located halfway down the access road, before reaching the construction zone.

We appreciate your immediate cooperation in keeping this thoroughfare clear for our utility partners and construction crews as we work toward completing these improvements in March. Please share this with all members of your household, especially those who might not be on this mailing list.
