

NOTICE TO RESIDENTS: TRAILHEAD PARKING LOT CONSTRUCTION AND CLOSURE

Lake Pointe Residents,

The Lake Pointe Municipal Utility District is pleased to provide an update on the Pedestrian Trailhead Parking Area Project, which is now officially in the construction phase. To ensure the safety of the community and the construction crews, the gravel lot at the bottom of the hill in the Preserve is closed and inaccessible to the public effective immediately.

The preliminary work on the site began this past Friday, February 27. While the District and its engineers are currently finalizing the full construction timeline, initial feedback from the contractor indicates that substantial work will be completed throughout the month of March.

For the safety of the community, we ask all residents to observe posted signage and remain outside the fenced construction zones at all times. While visitors may look for parking outside the fenced construction zone, you must not block the roadway. We encourage residents to park at Vista Pointe Park or in the small lot located halfway down the access road before reaching the construction zone.

We appreciate your patience and cooperation as we work to improve our community trail facilities. Updates on the project's progress will be posted periodically on the District website.
